What's new in Snow Inventory 3.2

3.2

- Support for Windows 7 and Windows Server 2008 R2
- Support for MS SQL Server 2000 detection (requires SP4)
- OpenSSL DLLs has been updated to version 0.9.8k
- Support for uploading data to Snow IDR server (web service)
- The server back-end will now only process files within the time specified in BackendStartTime and BackendStopTime in server.ini

3.1.2

- Now possible to start only front-end or back-end of the inventory server
- Improved Microsoft SQL Server detection
- Hide user names and IP addresses in the scanned result data to meet integrity demands
- Improved the software scanner to detect more applications
- Changes in the CPU detection procedure ensure all new processors are correctly detected
- Server connection to database is connected/disconnected for each data file processed in order to avoid connection time-outs

3.1.1

- Unique client ID - an alternative client identification method if you don't want to use computer names or mac addresses
- Inventory overview: Can now display several custom registry keys at one line by using a new concept named Query Mappings, giving the user a virtual table "UserDefined", which is available in the filter columns and query definitions
- Possibility to limit the number of returned records from database

3.1:

- More detailed and accurate metering
- Text stored as UNICODE in the database
- All user accounts reported as DOMAIN\USER

3.0.1:

- Support for remote MS SQL Servers
- Support for SQL Server instances
- Modified setup with upgrade from 3.0.0 features
- Updated with the latest OpenSSL components
- Small changes and optimizations to the database

Fixed Bugs

Bugs reported in Snow Inventory 3.0.0 – 3.1.2 and fixed in Snow Inventory 3.2.0

- Portable computer detection did fail in some cases
- Client deployment had some issues when upgrading an existing client
- Memory modules over 2GB not correctly detected
- Number of processor cores not correctly detected for certain processors
- Retrieving all environment variables (system and user)

Bugs reported in Snow Inventory 3.0.0 – 3.1.1 and fixed in Snow Inventory 3.1.2

- Some desktop machines did show up as laptops due to faulty detection
- Fixed: Send retry/expire did not work properly
- Fixed: Printer detection did not find all connected printers
- Minor adjustments and small bug fixes

Bugs reported in Snow Inventory 3.0.0 – 3.1.0 and fixed in Snow Inventory 3.1.1

- Fixed a resource leak in the metering client
- Several minor bug fixes
